ANNOUNCEMENT

The T&RA will be hosting these events. The Tournaments will be played in accordance with Rules established by the International Committee (IRTC).

The Team Events will commence in Friday 9 April 2010. The Cockram & Danby Trophies for over 50's and over 70s teams will be held at Lord's. The Bostwick Cup for over 60's teams will be held at Middlesex University Real Tennis Club. There will be a practice day for the Bostwick and Cockram teams on Thursday 8 April 2010 at each venue. The Danby Cup practice will be on Wednesday 7 April 2010 at Lord's. **National Associations are asked to advise as soon as possible which of the Team Events they will be entering and to make the appropriate payment (See General Information) by 15 February 2010.**

The Individual Championships will take place at The Queen's Club. Play will commence on Monday 11 April 2010. **Players must limit their entries to no more than four separate events.** If the number of entries is overwhelming, the Organising Committee will have the jurisdiction to limit this even further. All matches in all competitions will be the best of three 6 game sets.

Entries must arrive by post or e-mail no later than 15 February 2010, together with the appropriate fee. Please pay by Sterling Cheque payable to the T&RA, or online at www.tennisandrackets.com

Players in need of accommodation should signify this as early as possible. Every effort will be made to help those wishing to stay with UK hosts, although this avenue will be limited. Application for staying with UK hosts will be dealt with on a 'first come first served' basis.
