General Information

World Masters Amateur Team Challenge 9-11 April

The Bostwick Cup at Middlesex University, The Burroughs, 9-11 April 2010

The T&RA together with the MURTC will host this team event for eight players representing each country to play 2 Singles and 3 Doubles matches. To be eligible to compete, players must be 60 years of age or more at any time in 2010.

The Cockram Trophy at Lord's 9-11 April 2010

The T&RA together with the MCC Club will host this team event for seven players representing each country to play 3 Singles and 2 Doubles matches. To be eligible to compete, players must be 50 years of age or more at any time in 2010.

The Danby Trophy at Lord's 9-11 April 2010

The T&RA together with MCC will host this team event for 6 players representing each country to play 3 Doubles matches. To be eligible player must be 70 years of age or more at any time in 2010.

Practice days will be arranged as follows:

- Danby Trophy Teams at Lord's on Wednesday 7 April 2010;
- Bostwick Trophy Teams at MURTC on Thursday 8 April 2010;
- Cockram Trophy Teams at Lord's on Thursday 8 April 2010.

Entry Fees

To cover trophies, all court and marking fees, lunches on match days and Receptions at both Lords and Queens Club:

- Bostwick Cup** - £1000.00 per team
- Cockram Trophy** - £875.00 per team
- Danby Trophy** - £750.00 per team

Associations should make payment to the T&RA by 15 February 2010.

World Masters Amateur Singles & Doubles Championships at Queens Club **12-19 April 2010**

The T&RA together with Queens Club will host these events. To be eligible to compete, players must be over the relevant age at any time in 2010.

Entry Fees

To cover Championship shirt, trophies, all court & marking fees and a Reception at Queens Club:

- Singles events** £65.00 per event
- Doubles events** £47.50 per player per event

Players only entering one event will be required to pay a surcharge of £25.

There will be a charge of £25 per player's guest at the Reception on Thursday 8 April

There will be a charge of £25 per player's guest at the Reception on Monday 12 April

There will be a charge of £65 per player and per player's guest at the Dinner on Monday 19 April

The T&RA together with the Organising Committee will have the overall responsibility for planning and running all competitions.
